
According to the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force. Federal employees must receive their last dose of their vaccine no later than November 8, 2021, to meet the November 22, 2021 deadline to be fully vaccinated.

OCTOBER 11

Doses of the Moderna vaccine are given four weeks apart, so the first dose is needed by Oct. 11

OCTOBER 18

The two-dose Pfizer-BioNTech shots are generally administered three weeks apart, so workers will need to get their first shot by Oct. 18.

Covered workers have until Nov. 8 to get the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Fully vaccinated deadline: November 22,

CAUTION DATE: NOVEMBER 8

The task force cautioned that availability is limited in some locations, so workers may not be able to get the vaccine of their choice. "Agencies should encourage employees to plan ahead and allow enough time to receive all required vaccine doses before the Nov. 8 deadline to have their second shot,"
