
The following is a visual timeline for all to comply to the new OSHA Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) Vaccination Mandate.

# OSHA ETS Mandate VACCINE TIMELINE

The mandate means workers at larger businesses (100 or more) must get vaccinated for COVID-19 by Jan. 4, 2022.



### **NOVEMBER 28**

Doses of the Moderna vaccine are given four weeks apart, so the first dose is needed by Nov. 28

## **DECEMBER 5**

The two-dose Pfizer-BioNTech shots are generally administered three weeks apart, so workers will need to get their first shot by December 5.

# **DECEMBER 27**

Covered workers have until December 27 to get the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

# **JANUARY 4**

Deadline to have employees vaccinated under the OSHA Vaccination ETS

CAUTION: Availability is limited in some locations, so workers may not be able to get the vaccine of their choice. Employees should plan ahead and allow enough time to receive all required vaccine doses.
